Humane Education Ninth and Tenth Grade Program *No More Pro-Cat-stination!*

Objectives:

Students will be able to model population growth and analyze different strategies for managing growth of community cat populations to determine the most effective strategy.

Activity:

Led by instructor. The first five minutes of this lesson will be used to introduce what a cat colony is and why these cat colonies are a concern by using a quick news story clip and explanation of other reasons (public health, costs, suffering). The students will be divided into three workgroups and explore which seems to be the most effective strategy for managing community cat populations.
